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the sediment or outcome of the child's learning activity, is reflected in the child's becoming and finds expression in the fact that the child finds himself progressively behaving as an adult.

4.6 Further, it is important to heed that child learning is actualized by the child himself (see diagram on the course of learning) but that for the proper and responsible actualization of this, he is always dependent on the adult (parent or teacher) for educative instruction. Without this educative instruction as accompaniment during his becoming and learning, the child cannot become a proper adult.

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
